

## COUPLES DUPLICATE BRIDGE 2

This group meets on the **2nd Tuesday** of each month. We start at 4:00, and usually end by 7:30, to avoid late evenings and driving in the dark (most months). Normally there are three tables so six couples are required for play. We play four boards with each of five couples.



Each couple contributes \$2 and three couples will take money home.

The hosting is rotated among the regulars and the hosts provide snacks and refreshments (typically wine, soft drinks, munchies).

Currently, we have six regular couples but we often need subs and we would be happy to add you to the sub list. We try to give preference to our newer members, to get them engaged in SIR activities. Many wives appreciate this, as they too get to make new friends.

Eventually, attrition will occur, and a sub couple will be asked to join as regulars. (Subs do not have to host.) You do not have to be a married couple; some of our couples are just good friends.

This "duplicate" bridge is low-key. It is a very social activity.

People are competitive but in a very friendly way. There is no "director" as such. We are open to new members. It is not intimidating (easy for me to say, but come and see, or, call me and chat).
